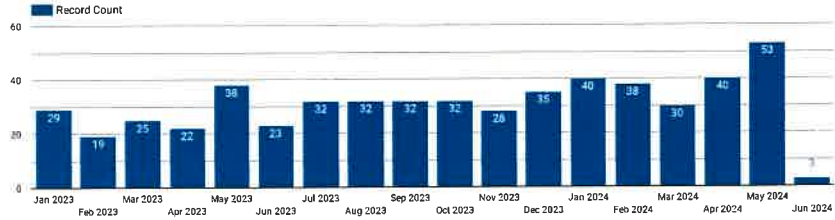

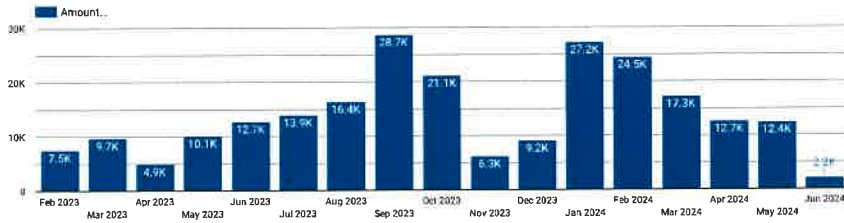

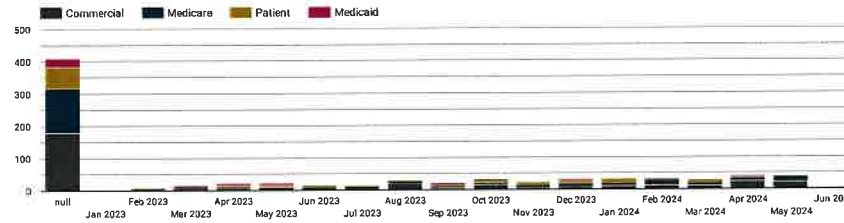


Total Cash By Posting Date

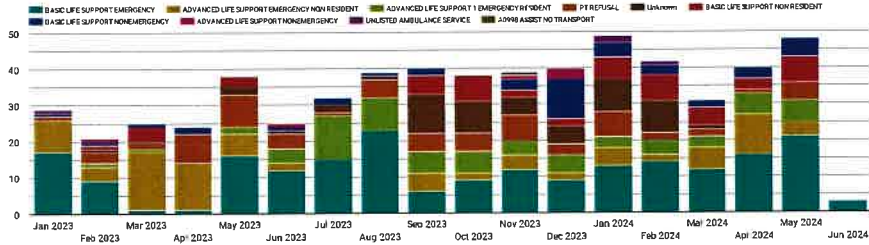


Primary Payer Breakdown



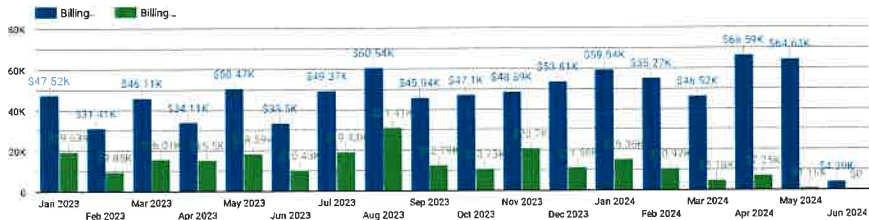

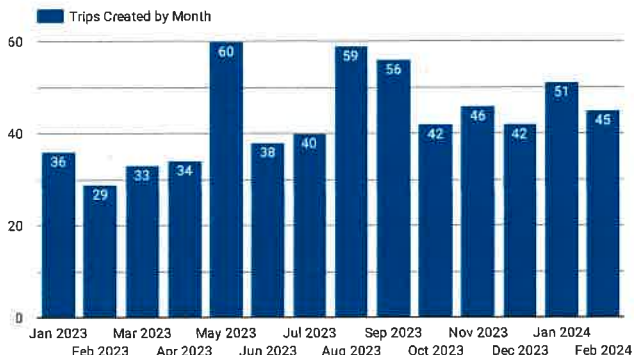

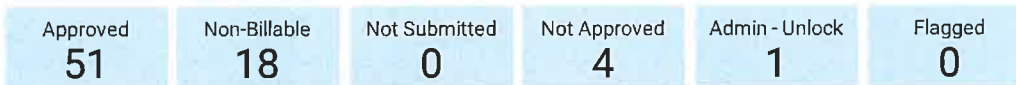

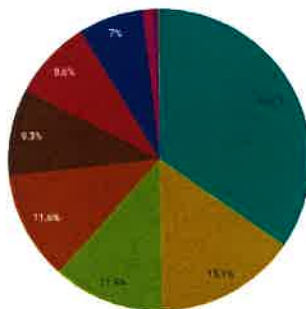

PCR Status Break Down



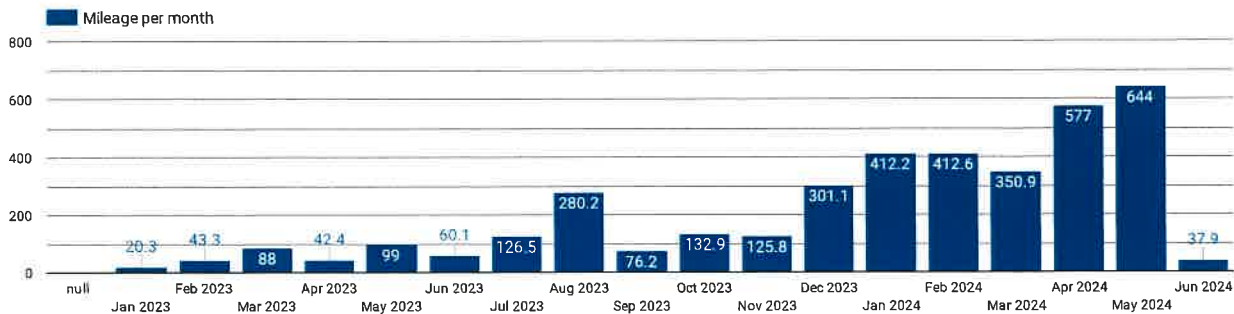

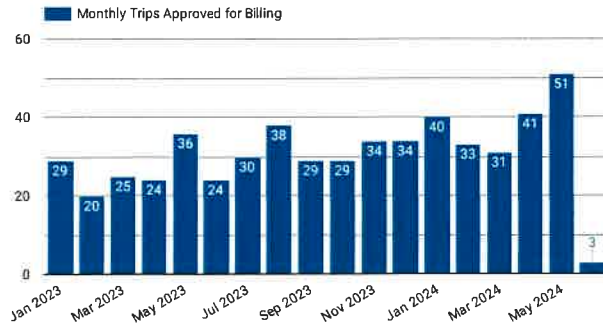

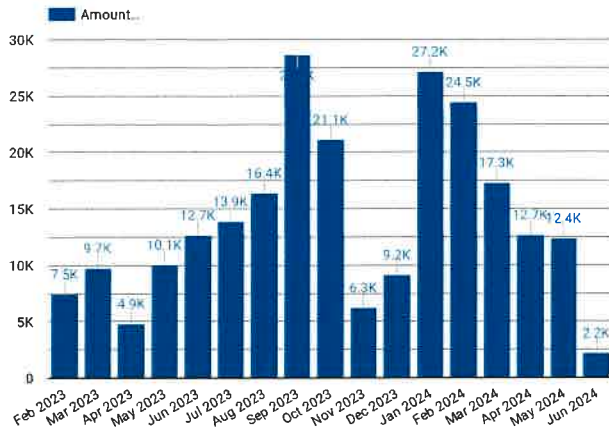

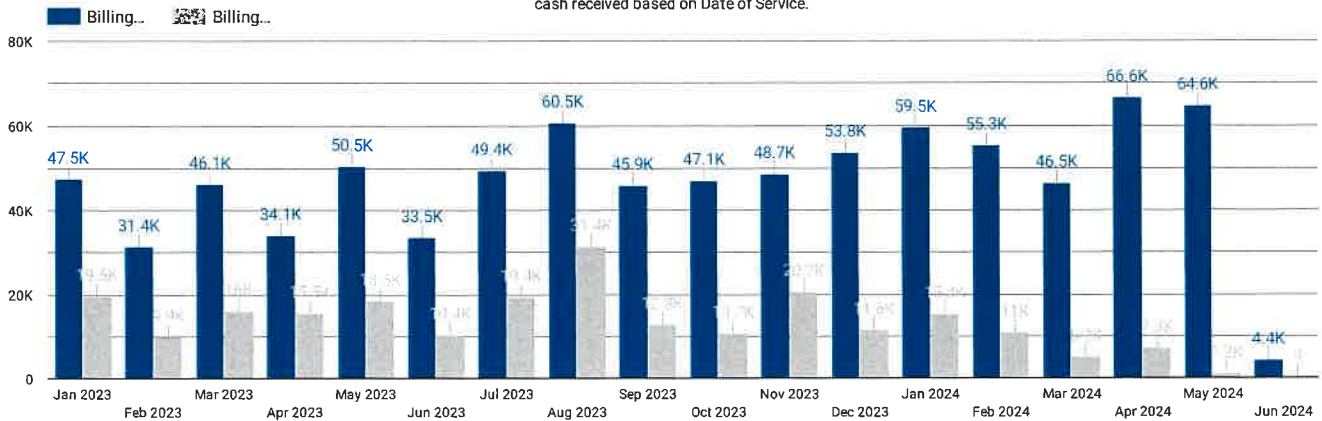
